Expected to be complete by mid-August.</li> <li>20k+ claims being processed in this reprocessing project</li> <li>Reminder: Pay to the contracted rate or billed amount whichever is lower.</li> </ul>
CLSS	Erik Carter	<ul> <li>Identified issue where CLSS claims that were submitted with the OHA approved modifier is being incorrectly denied.</li> <li>These are being reprocessed &amp; a fix in the CareOregon system has been implemented</li> <li>Method for reprocessing?</li> <li>For Providers who expressed concern during meeting about ICD amendments not coming thru, PRS will reach out to resolve.</li> <li>Why is HO Modifier being denied pre 7/1? Thought this was changing 6/1? Known issue?</li> <li>Do we continue using the CLSS modifiers or wait until fixed? Yes, please continue using the modifiers when billing.</li> <li>Clarified how to run CSV files with full data set out of CIM for quarterly reporting.</li> <li>Please contact your PRS or email bhcontracts@careoregon.org if you need more guidance or support or if you do not know who your Provider Relations Support specialist is.</li> </ul>

A: Any existing Authorization in CIM that crosses 10/1  DOS will be migrated into connect, and Providers can submit a claim with the CIM Authorization # in those scenarios.  Q: If you've already enrolled and been receiving payments through Payspan (now Zelis), is there any need for action?
