----- OHA (Oregon Health Authority) Resources ------

MMIS (Medicaid Management Information System)

MMIS is the State of Oregon's Medicaid Provider Portal and offers providers a variety of Medicaid-related details and resources.



Two common functions of MMIS include:

- 1. <u>Verifying eligibility</u> and a member's assigned CCO (Coordinated Care Organization)
 - a. Please note: If a member is assigned to "Health Share of Oregon" CCO, providers will need to use PH Tech's <u>CIM (Community Integration Manager)</u> to confirm which IDS (Integrated Delivery System) or ICN (Integrated Community Network) the member is assigned to within the CCO:

- 2. Reviewing the Prioritized List
 - a. The Prioritized List is used to confirm if the Oregon Health Plan considers a service as "covered."
 - b. Refer to the appropriate Health Plan to confirm if authorization is required.

CIM (Community Integration Manager)

After October 1st, 2023, CIM can be used for two primary functions:

- 1. Check claim & authorization status for dates of service <u>PRIOR TO</u> September 30th, 2023.
- 2. Verify health plan assignment. Under Health Share of Oregon, members may be assigned to one of the health plans listed below.
 - a. **NOTE:** CareOregon is the only Behavioral Health plan within Health Share of Oregon.

OneHealthPort (OneHealthPort Single Sign-On)

OneHealthPort has two primary functions:

- 1. Physical and Behavioral Health providers register with OneHealthPort for a CareOregon Connect account.
- 2. OneHealthPort is a Single Sign-On application that allows users to sign-in with one login and toggle between multiple health plan provider portals, such as the ones listed below:

CareOregon Connect (Online Provider Portal)

Our provider portal allows 24/7 access to:

- Check claim status & review remittance advice
- Submit & view authorizations
- Check eligibility & member information (including PCP assignment)
 - NOTE: Eligibility is limited to members assigned to Jackson Care Connect, Columbia Pacific, and Health Share members assigned to CareOregon
- Search and verify ICD-10, CPT, HCPC, revenue codes and modifiers
